Members of the Honors band are expected to meet the following criteria to receive an “A” in the class.

- 1) Be prepared daily to include:
 - a. Be seated and ready to play as soon as the bell rings.
 - b. Have instrument in working order.
 - c. Have all music and a PENCIL.
 - d. Be present at all sectionals.
 - e. Be prepared for tests. At least two performance (Chair) tests will be administered each six weeks.

- 2) Performance requirements are as follows:
 - a. Audition for the All-Region Band (Dec. 1)
 - b. Perform in All-Region Clinic/Concert if qualified (Jan. 18-19)
 - c. Christmas Concert
 - d. Pre-UIL Clinic and Concert (April 4 & 11)
 - e. UIL Solo & Ensemble Contest (Feb. 23)
 - f. UIL Concert and Sight-reading Contest (April 18)
 - g. Recruitment Concerts
 - h. Spring Concert
 - i. UIL State Solo & Ensemble Contest (if qualified – June 1)
 - j. Graduation Band (except seniors – May 24)

Members of the Honor Band must maintain academic eligibility. If a member becomes ineligible, their band assignment may be changed.

Members of the Honor Band are expected to have good rehearsal habits. Failure to practice good habits may result in band assignment change.

- a. No talking except when appropriate.
- b. No Gum in rehearsal.
- c. No hats in rehearsal.
- d. No Cell Phones in rehearsal. (Please refer to school rules and policies)
- e. No tardies to rehearsal.
- f. Courtesy towards each other and the directors.

Sectional Schedule – Sectionals will take place during the spring semester as we prepare for UIL Concert & Sight-reading Contest. Sectional will begin at 7 am and end at 7:45 am.

- a. Flutes and Oboes on Monday
- b. Clarinets on Tuesday
- c. Alto Saxes and French Horns on Wednesday
- d. Trumpets on Thursday
- e. Low Brass and Low WW on Friday

Private Lessons are available for most instruments. Honors Band students are highly encouraged to take private lessons. Private lesson scholarships are available for 50% of the cost. Please see Mr. McLellan for more information.
